Directions

RTA Routes:

The 25 and 45 Buses stop at W. 65th St. and Detroit Ave. less than one block from the Westside Housing Center. The Red Line's W. 65th Station is 1/2 mile south of the Westside Housing Center.

From Downtown Cleveland:

Take Superior Ave. west and cross the Detroit-Superior Bridge. Continue along Detroit Ave. and the Westside Housing Center is on your right shortly after W. 65th St.

From Lakewood and Points West:

Take Clifton Blvd. east and turn right onto Lake Ave. Turn left onto Detroit Ave. The Westside Housing Center is on your left shortly after W. 67th St.

From Brooklyn and Points South:

Take Ridge Rd. north and turn right on Denison Ave. Then turn left on W.65th St. and continue to Detroit Ave. The Westside Housing Center is less than one block west of the W.65th/Detroit Ave. intersection.

From Northeastern Neighborhoods:

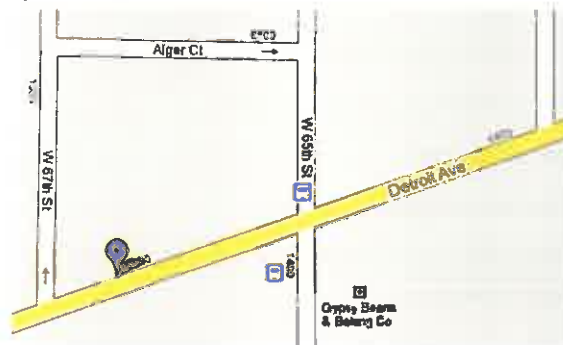
Take I-90 West toward downtown. Continue onto Route 2 toward Lakewood. Exit W. 49th St. and turn left onto W.49th St. Turn right onto Detroit Ave. The Westside Housing Center is on your right shortly after W. 65th St.

From Eastern Neighborhoods and University Heights:

Take Euclid Ave. west into downtown and turn left onto Superior Ave. Continue west over the Detroit-Superior Bridge along Detroit Ave. and the Westside Housing Center is on your right shortly after W. 65th St.

From Slavic Village and Points South:

Take I-77 North toward Downtown. Exit I-90 East through Midtown and then exit Route 2 West toward Lakewood. Exit W. 49th St. and turn left onto W.49th St. Turn right onto Detroit Ave. The Westside Housing Center is on your right shortly after W. 65th Street.

bilingual Foreclosure Prevention Advocate on staff full time to answer your questions and to provide help.
